



# Tender Earth


# Torsa

## Belgian bluestone

Belgian bluestone or "Little Granite" is a limestone with a more or less pronounced natural blue/grey colour, which is characterized by the presence of a large number of fossilised crinoids. This type of bluestone is only quarried in Belgium.

- It develops a natural patina
  - Use: outdoors, changes due to the action of rain and UV-rays to its original pale blue-grey colour
  - Use: indoors in the course of time, it develops a deeper colour
- Bluestone is susceptible to products and scratches
- Belgian bluestone can often contain a number of white veins<sup>1</sup>, black lines, spots and fossils<sup>2</sup>
- Depending on the finishing, the stone has a different look

<sup>1</sup> "White veins" are water veins, formed by water, 100% specific to bluestone and are not cracks as people often assume.

<sup>2</sup> Fossils and colour differences: stone is a natural material formed by different perfectly petrified fossils. So it is normal to find nests of crustaceans in the stone.

In other words, even in one sheet of stone clear differences in colour can be observed.


